This is Jayden, he plays the character called **Jamal**.




This is Billy, he plays the character called **Connor.**

She makes music by **beatboxing**.




Beatboxing means using your **voice** and a **microphone** to make sounds.

One of the **screens** will show the **words** the actors are saying. These are called **captions**.




The **actors** will use **props**, **furniture** and **costumes** to help tell their **stories**.

Then there is a **15-minute break**, called an **interval**.




The **second half** of the play is **40 minutes** long.
